A summary of your feedback



The most popular feature of the concept plan was the new park furniture and picnic facilities.



Most respondents said they take children to playspaces with the most common age of these children being 3-5 years old.



The most popular items of play equipment were climbing items, swings and a flying fox.



Feedback was positive and supportive of the landscape and playspace concept design.



Feedback supported the wide range of users the design would allow for.

659 postcards were posted to local residents, businesses and other properties.



23 emails were sent to participants who elected to be kept informed during previous community consultation.



The participate page was open from November 26 - January 10 and received 187 visits.

40% of visitors to the page became informed by clicking on or downloading a document.

10% of visitors to the page provided feedback via the online survey.
